

Tips for shooting video B-Roll and Cut Aways

1. . All the time!!!!
2. your
subject try to show a clear intent (do not search for the shot as you roll). Try to imagine that your camera is very heavy and has lots of inertia.
3. . Pick a position and always
shoot 2 or 3 shots that can be edited into a sequence. A Wide Shot (WS) a Medium Shot (MS) and a Close UP (CU). Avoid stand alone shots
4. and you feel you
can visualize the sequence of shots. If you run out of ideas, stop and regroup.
5. . DO NOT STOP RECORDING IMMEDIATELY AFTER
YOUR TILT/PAN.
6. But Try to avoid the zoom while
recording though unless it's necessary.
